820-INCH N/A ENGINE IN SUPER STREET

NPS Record Holders, the Vorderers, have recently decided to set-up up their program to run in the NMCA's Outlaw 10.5W class, Super Street. Currently, the wicked '69 Camaro is at Metz Performance in Wisconsin being updated to do battle in S/S for the 2008 season. They are planning on staying with the same type of step-up that set the world record in NPS during the 2007 season, that being naturally aspirated. The biggest difference is the displacement. Instead of 632 inches of wedge, they opted for an 820-inch Sonny Leonard Semi-Hemi backed by a 5-speed. This is going to one of the few naturally aspirated Outlaw 10.5W cars in the country, so this will be one car to keep an eye on.
